

Make your own Code Wheel

Code wheels allow you to create and read simple codes.

To make your code wheel:

- 1. Cut out both wheels
- 2. Put the smaller wheel on top of the larger one
- 3. Carefully put a paper fastener through the centre of both wheels and fold the ends back

To use your code wheel: turn the inner wheel to create a code. For example, a simple code could be a 'shift' code where 'a' becomes 'b' and 'b' becomes 'c' etc. To do this align the 'a' on the inner side with the 'b' on the outside. To write a coded message look for the original letter on the inner wheel and write down the letter on the outer wheel.
